

NOTE from the PASTOR

The month of August is devoted to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. And we celebrate the feast of Mary's assumption into heaven on August 15. May we pray without ceasing that her Immaculate Heart will soon triumph! I entrust our churches and families to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Please also be sure to remember that August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption. This is a Holy Day of Obligation, so be sure to check for the Mass schedule!

As we introduced in mid-July, we welcome Stephen, Connor, and Benjamin as postulants to the Oratory. Please remember that they are very much at the beginning of their formation and need room to adapt to the Oratorian life. They also need space to grow in virtue, prayer, and general formation. Certainly, be friendly and strike up a conversation when you see them. However, please be sure to respect any boundaries and not place them in situations or conversations that would be inappropriate to their position. I appreciate your cooperation! Please remember them in your daily prayers and for all those discerning the Oratorian life.

As we continue with the Beacons of Life process, we are in the position to proceed with the merger that the Archbishop envisions for each of the families. I have addressed this via my sermons this summer, and the feedback has generally been positive. I challenge everyone on how they can be involved in the parish? Without you and your involvement, doing anything would not be easy. We each

have a role to play in the life of the Church. We have an excellent foundation to build on, but we must always be building to pass the torch on to future generations.

I challenge everyone to consider any special talent or trade you may have to be willing to share that with the parish. I also challenge each of you to ensure that you are involved somehow. We are commuting churches, making operating like a normal parish difficult. However, there are ways for everyone to be involved somehow, whether through your prayer, volunteer work, or just being present and knowing one another. Adoration can always use more adorers. Our choir can always also use more skilled voices. Help cleaning the churches is also necessary, and we can use more help from experienced volunteers on many maintenance needs. Polishing the items used in the sanctuary is an essential thing that needs to be done often. And, of course, there is always the decorating for our major holy days. Lastly, we can always use more Altar boys/men for our 11:30 Sunday German Mass, 1:00 Sunday English Mass, and Monday and Saturday daily Mass. That help to get things set up and cleaned up for Mass, and someone just helping during Mass is essential. Beacons of Light wants to ensure we cover these things, so I am asking for your help in various ways as you can.

You will continue to hear more about these things. The priests can't do everything alone, but we can hand these gems to future generations together.




Women's Oratory

Old Saint Mary's Parking

We have three parking lots that are owned and managed by the Church (P1, P2, and P3). OSM parking lots provide a total of 46 spaces for parishioners and 7 reserved spaces for use by clergy. Parking lots P1 and P2 are leased after hours (5 p.m. to 6 a.m.) to a local real estate management company for use as paid public parking. As a result of this lease, OSM receives nonexclusive use of the Salvation Army parking lots on Sundays and some Holy Days throughout the calendar year. The Salvation Army lots provide an additional 67 spaces of nonexclusive use by parishioners.

Guidelines for Use:

- Parking passes are only valid when the lots have been reserved for official
 Church events. Parking passes must be displayed on your vehicle dash when
 using OSM lots after 5 p.m. and when using the Salvation Army lots. Failure
 to do so will result in your vehicle being towed. Use of passes outside of official
 Church events will also result in your vehicle being towed.
- Double parking is permitted in the OSM P2 lot only. Double parking in any of the other OSM and Salvation Army lots will result in your vehicle being towed.
- If you decide to double park in the OSM P2 lot, please be respectful of other parishioners and have your vehicle out of the right-of-way immediately following Mass.
- Use of parking passes for any non-related church activities is prohibited and will result in your vehicle being towed.
- Gates on the Salvation Army P3 lot will be locked at 2 p.m. each Sunday. Vehicles remaining in this lot after that time will be towed.
- The gate on the OSM P3 lot is secured at 9:30 p.m. each evening.
- * Please note, the warm weather has brought about issues and concerns in the OSM P1 lot. This lot is secured at 1:00 PM every Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. This will continue throughout September.

The rink will be reserved for parish use from 6-8 p.m. on **Wednesday, August 2**. Cost is 20\$ per family and includes skate rental. Proceeds will cover rink reservation and any additional proceeds will be used for our parish catechism program. You may pay by cash or check made out to Old St Mary the evening of the event.
